PRESIDENT'S REPORT

"Suffrage is the pivotal right!"

- Susan B. Anthony

We are a relatively young country founded on two of the greatest documents in human history. The Declaration of Independence and The US Constitution. Although these tools of liberation set free a new world for generations to come, they left out many people either by intent or simply by omission.

As a result of that, almost 150 years after the birth of our nation most women were rewarded for their crawl towards equality. On August 18, 1920, the 19th Amendment to the US Constitution was ratified into law, and women were finally given the right to vote. Now women could begin to participate and, in many cases, lead toward a better future.

On August 18, 2020, we will celebrate the 100th anniversary of the 19th amendment to the Constitution. As they say in Mary Poppins – "Well done sister suffragettes!"

However, while some women were able to walk right into a voting booth at the next election, many women were still unable to vote. Women of African American, Asian American, Hispanic American, and Native American heritage were still not officially allowed to vote and make their voices heard.

It took another 45 years when the Voting Rights Act was passed that women of color were allowed to exercise their right to vote.

But there's more. Although all women now had the right to vote there were still inequities holding them back. A woman was not able to obtain a mortgage in her name, she could not get a credit card of her own and she would, therefore, be unable to purchase a home. The enactment of the Equal Credit Opportunity Act in 1974 made it illegal for lenders to deny loans to any person based on gender. This opened a world of credit to women for the first time. Credit cards, auto loans, and mortgages were available to any woman who could afford them.

It took almost 200 years since the founding of the United States to realize some sense of equality for women in this country. It was a new era of financial independence. And women were now off and running to positions of true power and leadership.

We still have a long way to go to achieve equal rights for all and equitable pay for women. However, thanks to the decades-long persistent fight and the perseverance of women like Susan B. Anthony, we celebrate a pivotal milestone in our history this month. The centennial anniversary of the 19th Amendment!



Brief Update about Changes with LARA

- New licenses will not be issued from August 3-August 25, 2020
- · LARA's online platform moving to MiPLUS beginning August 25, 2020
- Online services not available for real estate brokers, salespersons beginning August 3, 2020

As you may have heard by now, LARA will be implementing a new software system that promises to provide better search and reporting features, as well as ease of access for its users. To accommodate this switchover, they will be shutting down their current system between August 5-25, 2020. What does that mean for you?

For most, you may not even notice this has happened. However, for those who are wishing to enter the industry, reinstate a license, or transfer a brokerage, you will have to make some adjustments to your original plans.

With the system being shut down entirely during that time, new license applications (for both broker, salesperson, and reinstatements) will not be issued. Testing will continue through PSI Services, LLC, but again, licenses will not be issued between August 3 through August 25, 2020. LARA is encouraging brokers to continue to onboard during that time with some slight adjustments to the list of items that new team member is able to do. For example, they would be able to do anything an unlicensed assistant can do during the interim.

This will also impact anyone who is looking to transfer to another brokerage during that time, as they will not be accepting any transfer applications online either. What LARA has recommended is to use a paper process for any transfers during this time and to have the exiting broker sign the back of the individual's pocket card.

While LARA is in this transition, you will still be able to perform license verification between August 3 and August 25, however, the information on the site will only be current through August 3.

One other very important item to note with the switch to the new MiPLUS system is that when you renew your current license by October 31, 2021, for the first time in the MiPLUS system, your new license will have an expiration date that corresponds to the date you first received your professional license or the anniversary date of receiving your license. We will continue to send out more information as it becomes available, but its good to get in the mindset now that all licenses will not expire on October 31st after this upcoming renewal.

Our staff has available all of the PDF documents from LARA in the event you need one, please let us know.

JUNE REAL ESTATE MARKET COMMENTARY (from Leads Sheet)

While much of the country was working on a phased reopening of the economy in June, real estate activity continued to strengthen – both from a month-over-month and year-over-year perspective, the former at dramatic levels.

Month-Over-Month: According to numbers tracked by ShowingTime, pent up demand by prospective home buyers fueled historic increases in June 2020 in a number of key areas including:

- Closed Sales: 114% increase M-O-M from low in May 2020
- Pending Sales: 29% increase M-O-M from May 2020; 316% increase from low in April 2020
- New Listings: 8% increase M-O-M from May 2020; 261% increase from low in April 2020
- Inventory of Homes for Sale: Remained virtually the same M-O-M as compared to May 2020; 9% increase from low in April 2020

JUNE 2020 QUICK TAKES



Year-Over-Year: Positive signs of recovery in June 2020 also extended to a comparison with June 2019. Those numbers included the following:

- Pending Sales: 14.9% increase Y-O-Y from June 2019 to 10,073
- Median Sales Price: 6.6% increase Y-O-Y from June 2019 to \$202,500
- Average Sales Price: 2.8% increase Y-O-Y from June 2019 to \$234,563
- Average Showings per Home: 11, 52% increase Y-O-Y from June 2019

LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

Greater REALTORS® Vote!

Contested primary elections in local races are often decided by incredibly small margins—so it's very important that your voice is heard in the election on August 4th!

In May, GMAR's Candidate Endorsement Task Force met 21 times totaling 72 hours conducting interviews of 140 candidates running for federal, state, and local office. Each of those candidates were asked about why they're running for office, why they sought our endorsement, and tough questions on issues impacting the way we do business.

It's important to note that while GMAR's Endorsements are listed by party, it was done for ease of use! Michigan law prohibits voters from voting for candidates from both parties in the August Primary Election. Meaning,

those who vote in the Republican primary can only vote for Republicans, and vice versa for Democrats. When you vote in the coming weeks, be sure to consider supporting GMAR's Endorsed Candidates with respect to the party primary you are voting in!

It's also important to note that you do not have to go to the polls to vote! Consider voting with an Absentee Ballot, which you can now request online by visiting mvic.sos.state.mi.us/application. Voting from the safety and convenience of home has never been easier!


Who doesn't think that 2020 has been an interesting year?

Future Guardian Angels Medical Service Dog Named by Michigan Residents Begins Life-Changing Training





Training Fully Sponsored by the Greater Metropolitan Association of REALTORS® and the Michigan State Police

WILLISTON, FLA (July 10, 2020) – This past March, Michigan residents voted to name a future **Guardian Angels Medical** Service Dog sponsored by the Greater Metropolitan Association of REALTORS® (GMAR) and the Michigan State Police's 135th Trooper Recruit School. In overwhelming numbers, the public chose the name Tuebor – taken from the Michigan state seal meaning "I will defend." Tuebor garnered nearly 60 percent of online votes in the naming contest. When the name was chosen, Tuebor was yet to be born, but Guardian Angels is thrilled now to introduce future super service dog Tuebor!

Tuebor will be trained by Guardian Angels Medical Service Dogs in Williston, Florida. Guardian Angels is a national 501(c)3 nonprofit organization that exists to rescue, raise, train and donate medical service dogs to veterans, first responders and individuals with both visible and invisible disabilities, and has placed more than 25 dogs with deserving recipients in Michigan alone, with more than 330 paired in 26 states nationally.

Since little Tuebor is only a few months old now, he's learning just the basics – potty training; commands such as "heel, sit, down and come;" as well as an exercise called "paws." Paws is a very important command for service dogs. They place their front legs up on a chair and stay. This makes it easy for recipients who may have mobility or balance issues to put on their service dog's vest, without having to bend all the way over. Tuebor is also working on audio desensitization, socialization, enrichment exercises and building his confidence. At this point in his training, all of his time in Guardian Angels' exclusively positive reinforcement "school" is without a leash or collar - that training will come later. In the future, Tuebor will go on to support his handler by mitigating symptoms of a variety of visible and invisible disabilities. These could include PTSD, traumatic brain

injury, seizure and diabetic disorders, mobility issues, or any number of other disorders. Unfortunately, on average 22 veterans in the United States succumb to suicide each day. After being paired with a Guardian Angels' medical service dog, that rate has dropped to zero amongst recipients. Divorce rates and medication use also dramatically decrease with the pairing of a medical service dog. Among combat veteran families who have received a medical service dog from Guardian Angels the divorce rate is less than two percent.

Fundraising for Tuebor began when recruits from Michigan State Police's 135th Trooper Recruit School met a Guardian Angels' recipient at a local gym and decided to dedicate their "Workout of the Day" to raise funds for a service dog to support a disabled veteran. In total, the recruits raised more than \$9,200 with GMAR stepping in to donate the remaining balance for a total of \$25,000, the full cost of training one dog.

In 2015, GMAR started its ongoing "5 Years, 5 Dogs, 5 Lives Saved" campaign, in which they will donate funds for five service dogs. Since starting the campaign, the Association has sponsored the training for Cobalt REALTOR® Blue, Thor, Indy and Tuebor. Cobalt and Thor have since been paired with recipients, while Indy is currently in training at Guardian Angels' headquarters in Florida, but due to be paired with her recipient soon!

Guardian Angels have been previously recognized by the Academy of United States Veterans (AUSV) at its annual VETTYS awards; and the one of the nonprofit's service dogs, Alice, was named the top service dog in the United States as the 2019 American Humane Hero Dog of the Year.

Guardian Angels Medical Service Dogs is a 501(c)3 nonprofit organization based in Williston, Florida and has grown into a nationwide medical service dog organization. The organization rescues, raises, trains & then donates individually trained medical service dogs to veterans, first responders and others who suffer from disabilities including PTSD, Traumatic Brain Injury, diabetic and seizure disorders, mobility issues and more. Over the past 10 years, Guardian Angels has paired more than 325 individually trained medical service dogs with recipients in 24 states and trained the #1 Service Dog in the US and the top American Dog Hero. PROTECT YOUR CREDIT

Understanding the CARES Act & Your Credit









If you are facing financial difficulties because of the COVID-19 pandemic, act now to protect your credit. The **CARES Act** implemented provisions to protect consumers' credit scores from January 30, through July 25, 2020, or after the coronavirus national emergency is declared over, whichever is later.

KNOW YOUR RIGHTS

If your accounts were current as of February 1, and you are making payments, or made arrangements not to make payments, your creditors, including landlords, must report you as being current on your payments. If you were previously delinquent, but were able to make a repayment plan with the creditor and you are now current on that plan, then your account must be reported as current.



However, you MUST reach out to your creditor (the servicer, bank or credit card company that gave you the loan or extended credit to you) to arrange for forbearance or a payment alternative if you are having trouble making your payments. It is only after making arrangements for repayment that you will be given this protection.

CHECK YOUR CREDIT REPORT

You are entitled to a free credit report every 12 months from each of the three major credit reporting companies; TransUnion, Equifax, and Experian. You can request and review your free report by visiting annualcreditreport.com or calling 1-877-322-8228. You may opt to request all three reports at one time. However, if you request a report from just one of the companies every four months, you can check your credit throughout the year, as most of the same information is reported with all three organizations.

CREDIT SCORE



FIX INACCURATE INFORMATION

To dispute an error on your credit report, you should contact both the credit reporting company and your creditor - the company that provided the information.

The dispute processes are similar for credit reporting companies and creditors. You must explain in writing what you think is wrong, why, and provide copies of documents that support your claim.

The Consumer Financial Protection Bureau (CFPB) provides resources at cfpb.gov to help consumers dispute an error on their credit report.

Credit reporting companies (CRC) are required to investigate your dispute, contact the creditor who provided the information, and report the results back to you unless they determine your claim is frivolous. If they believe your claim is frivolous, the CRC must send you a notice within five days of receiving the claim, saying that it has made such a determination, and that it will not investigate.

If the creditor corrects your information after your dispute, it must notify all of the credit reporting companies to which it sent the inaccurate information, so that they can correct their reports. That way you only have to contest the inaccurate information once, and not with each individual credit reporting company.

DEFINITIONS

CORONAVIRUS AID, RELIEF, AND ECONOMIC SECURITY (CARES) ACT:

The CARES Act provides support to individuals and businesses affected by the coronavirus pandemic and economic downturn.

CREDIT SCORE:

A credit score predicts how likely you are to pay back a loan on time. A scoring model uses information from your credit report to create a credit score.

CREDIT REPORT:

A credit report is a statement that has information about your credit activity and current credit situation such as loan paying history and the status of your credit accounts.

CREDIT REPORTING COMPANIES:

Credit reporting companies, also known as credit bureaus or consumer reporting agencies, are companies that compile credit reports.
